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1 Policy Detail

1.1 General.

- 1.1.1 The GDPR states that the controller and the processor shall designate a data protection officer in any case where:
 - 1.1.1.1 The processing is carried out by a public authority or body, except for courts acting in their judicial capacity;
 - 1.1.1.2 The core activities of the controller or the processor consist of processing operations which, by virtue of their nature, their scope and/or their purposes, require regular and systematic monitoring of data subjects on a large scale; or
 - 1.1.1.3 The core activities of the controller or the processor consist of processing on a large scale of special categories of data pursuant to Article 9 and personal data relating to criminal convictions and offences referred to in Article 10.

1.2 Assessment.

- 1.1.2 ACE Schools MAT does need a data protection officer because we do meet one or more of the criteria detailed above.
