TRANSFERS OF PERSONAL DATA TO THIRD COUNTRIES PROCEDURE

1 Scope

- 1.1 This procedure applies where, in accordance with the GDPR, ACE Schools MAT wishes to transfer personal data to third countries outside of the EU for processing. This includes the onward transfer of personal data from the third country as well as to another international organisation within the scope of this procedure.

2 Responsibilities

- 2.1 It is the responsibility of ACE Schools MAT to ensure that the appropriate level of protection of personal data of natural persons guaranteed by the GDPR is not undermined.

3 Transfers of personal data to third countries or international organisations procedure

- 3.1 When transferring personal data to third countries or international organisations outside of the EU, ACE Schools MAT shall ensure that an adequate level protection has been established as follows:
 - 3.1.1 That the country (or industry sector within that country) of the recipient is on the EU approved list of countries as set out in the *Official Journal of the European Union*;
 - 3.1.2 ACE Schools MAT has a contract in place, which uses either existing or approved data protection clauses to ensure adequate protection;
 - 3.1.3 That the company receiving the data is on Privacy Shield.
